Commissioner Braddock called the Meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with four Commissioners present.

Commissioner Schmidt moved to adopt the Agenda as presented. Commissioner Puckett seconded the Motion and it was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Schwieterman made the Motion to approve the Minutes of the January 16, 2007, Commissioners' Meeting as printed. Commissioner Braddock seconded. The Motion passed unanimously.

Delmar Hammond, County Road Supervisor, gave his weekly report to the Commissioners. Mr. Hammond reported that one of the Dresser graders had lost its transmission. Snow removal on County roads was progressing at a slow rate due to the wind and more snow being received. A letter from Mike and Nancy Lewis regarding a portion of the river road was reviewed and discussed.

Mavis Long, Director of the VIP Center, invited the Commissioners to lunch at the VIP Center on January 29, Kansas Day. She also discussed a letter of support needed for two grants she was applying for—one for a new vehicle for the VIP Center and the other for operating funds for the Center. The Clerk will get that letter to her.

The Commissioners discussed the updated 5-year plan. Commissioner Schwieterman reported that the storage room at the Health Department was finished and he would be ordering new shelving for that room.

Commissioner Puckett is waiting on the specs for the heaters on the Courthouse roof.

The appointment to the Planning Commission was discussed. Commissioner Braddock made the Motion appointing Dave Erwin to the Planning Commission for a three-year term. Commissioner Schwieterman seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Two estimates for the clean up of the yard at the Donahue Building from the ice and snow storms were reviewed. Commissioner Braddock moved that Matt Gould's bid of \$124.00 be accepted. Commissioner Schwieterman seconded. The Motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Braddock moved that warrants in the amount of \$82,059.90 be approved. Commissioner Schmidt seconded and the Motion was unanimously approved.

The Clerk reported that Pioneer Communications had finished installing the new telephone system throughout the Courthouse.

As there was no more business to come before the meeting, Commissioner Schwieterman moved for adjournment. Commissioner Schmidt seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 10:07 a.m.
