Commissioner Schwieterman moved that the Budget Hearing concerning the 2008 Hamilton County Budget be held on August 14, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., after publication as required by statute. Commissioner Schmidt seconded the Motion. It was unanimously approved.

Delmar Hammond, County Road Supervisor, gave his weekly report to the Commissioners.

The repairs being done to the Museum Building and the needed repairs to the Health Building were discussed.

The salvage yard matter is still on hold.

An estimate for the covering of the Donohue Building windows is expected.

The parking at the swimming pool is still on hold. The placement of the handicapped seat at the swimming pool was discussed.

Commissioner Schwieterman moved that warrants in the amount of \$114,618.81 be approved. Commissioner Braddock seconded and the Motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Schwieterman reported the County purchased of a 10' speed mover for the fairgrounds for the sum of \$2100.00

Commissioner Schwerdfeger moved for a 10-minute executive session in order to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel, coming out of the executive session at 11:33 a.m. Commissioner Braddock seconded and the Motion was approved.

The regular meeting reconvened at 11:33 a.m.

As there was no more business to come before the meeting, Commissioner Schwieterman moved for adjournment. Commissioner Schwerdfeger seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 11:34 a.m.
